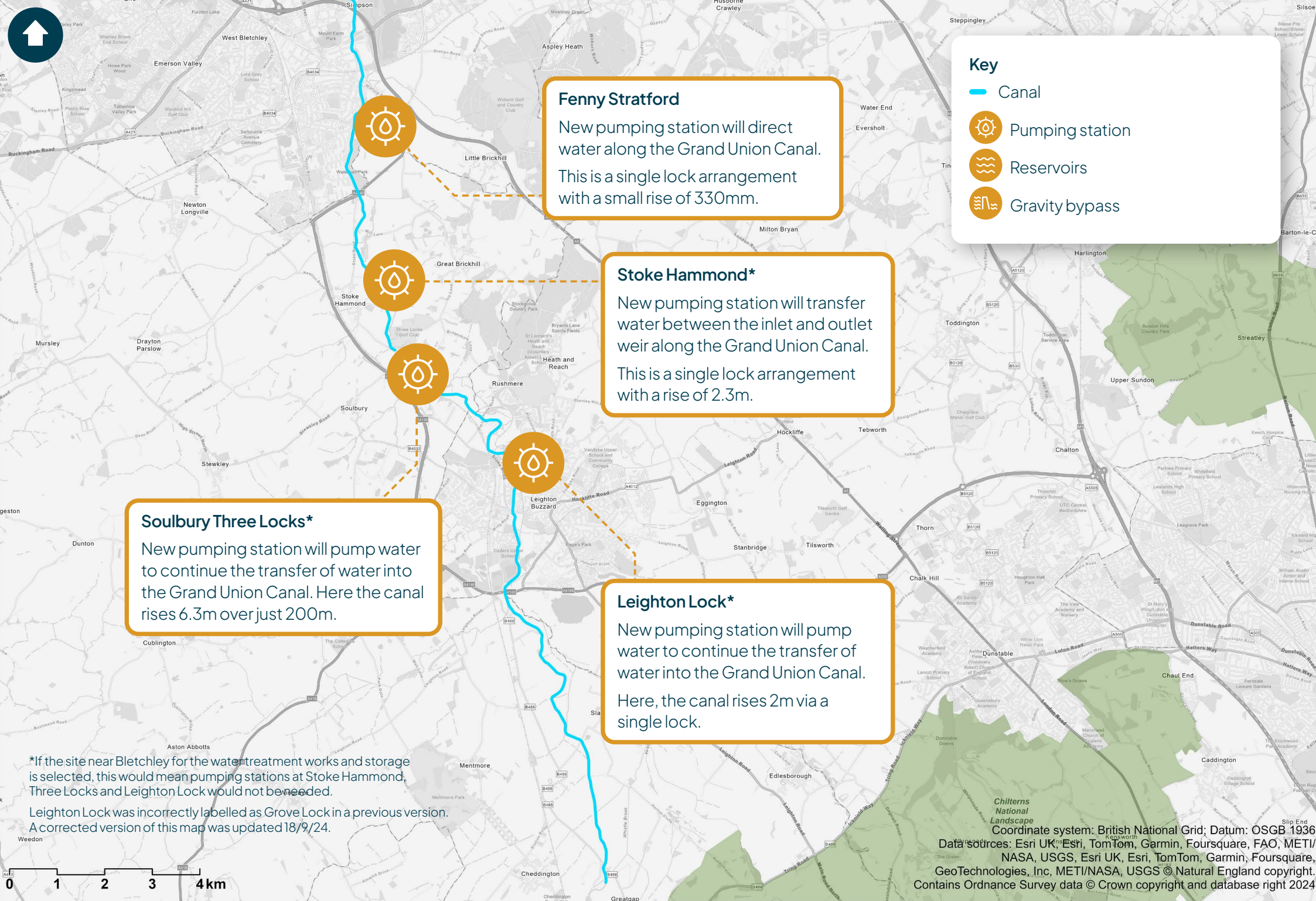




Key

Fenny Stratford

New pumping station will direct water along the Grand Union Canal.

This is a single lock arrangement with a small rise of 330mm.

Stoke Hammond*

New pumping station will transfer water between the inlet and outlet weir along the Grand Union Canal.

This is a single lock arrangement with a rise of 2.3m.

Soulbury Three Locks*

New pumping station will pump water to continue the transfer of water into the Grand Union Canal. Here the canal rises 6.3m over just 200m.

Leighton Lock*

New pumping station will pump water to continue the transfer of water into the Grand Union Canal.

Here, the canal rises 2m via a single lock.

*If the site near Bletchley for the water treatment works and storage is selected, this would mean pumping stations at Stoke Hammond, Three Locks and Leighton Lock would not be needed.

Leighton Lock was incorrectly labelled as Grove Lock in a previous version. A corrected version of this map was updated 18/9/24.
