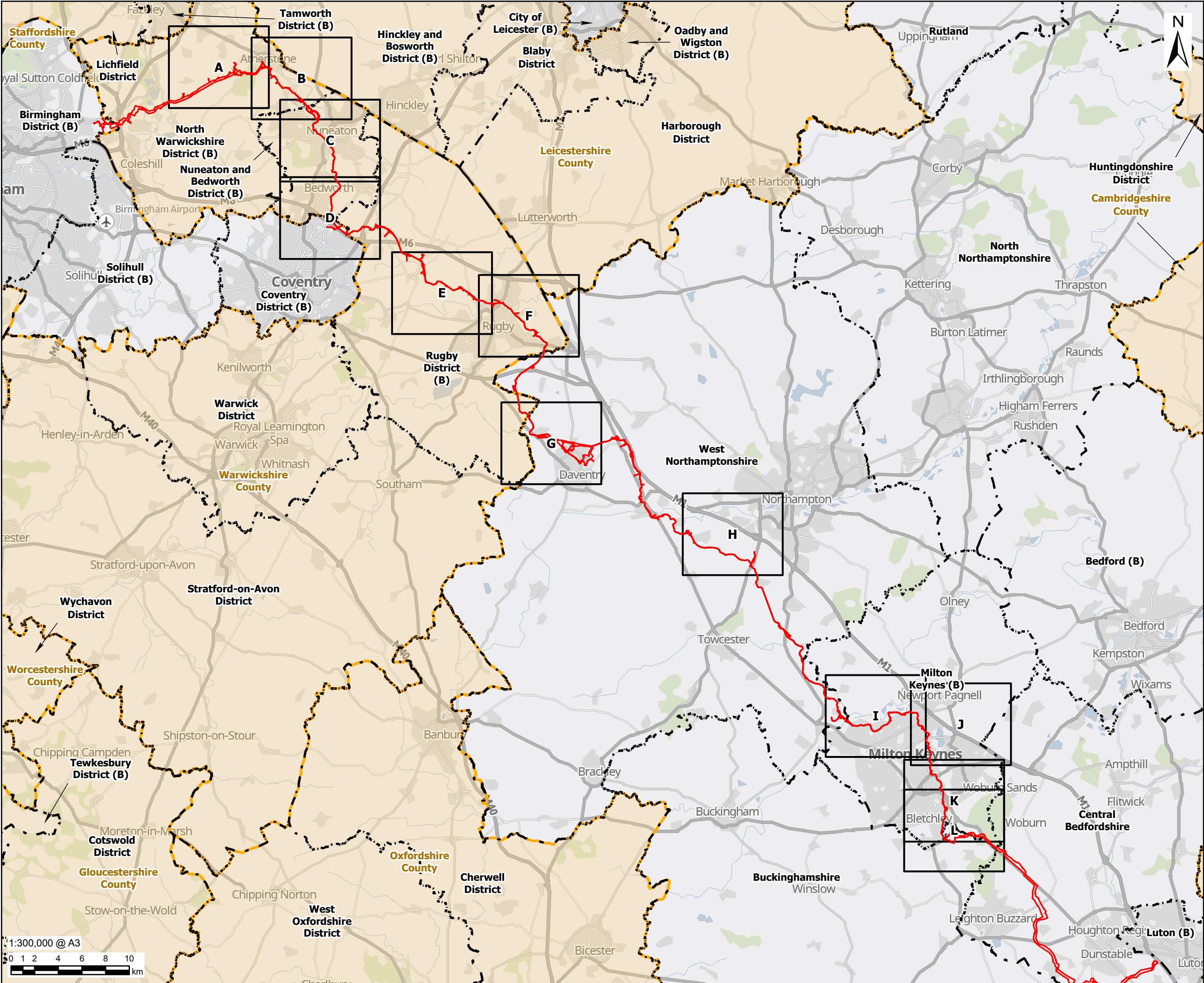


**Figure 12-P2-3: Part 2 - Invasive Non-Native
